(6) A feed-heater may be used in the case of a non-condensing engine, to recover some of the waste heat in the exhaust steam. (7) Steam-jackets and reheaters are added to the engine under certain circumstances. No portion of a steam plant is perfect, and each is the seat of losses more or less serious.
