Those which are slightly salted and smoked only for a few hours, are called bloaters; but the greater part are buried in salt for ten days; then they are taken up and strung on sticks run through their gills, and smoked for about a fortnight longer; these are called red herrings. The herring fishery begins about Michaelmas, and lasts twelve or fourteen weeks; the mackerel fishery then begins, and lasts through the winter months, many of the boats going as far as Plymouth, in Devonshire, to look after the fish.
